You will need:

A Row of your Choice
FQG I 22 Stacking Pop-Up Pattern
FQG I 24 Large 10.5" Spring Refill

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Important Before You Begin!!!

The row will be cut down
from 36-1/2" wide to 34-1/2" wide!!!

Please make sure your row has 2" of extra in width
that can be cut off!

Row design must have a landscape format

Max size including seam allowance:

9-1/2" tall x 36-1/2" wide.

Directions:

Make your row using the pattern from a participating quilt shop. Row is usually 9-1/2" x 36-1/2" after piecing with seam allowance.

Row: Trim pieced row down to 34-1/2" wide.

Out of a coordinating fabric:

cut (1) strip 1-1/2" x 34-1/2" for bottom edge,

cut (1) strip *2-1/2" x 34-1/2" for top edge

**if row is less than 9-1/2" tall,*

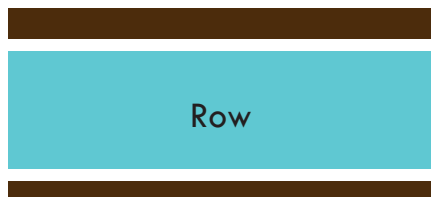
use the formula below to calculate the height of the top strip:

$$12" - (\text{height of row}) = (\text{height of top strip})$$

$$\text{Example: } 12" - 9\text{-}1/2" = 2\text{-}1/2".$$

cut (1) circle 11" for the outer base.

Refer to the piecing diagram and sew the bottom (1-1/2") strip to the bottom of the row. Sew the top (2-1/2") strip to the top of the row. Press to strips. Final pieced size: 12-1/2" x 34-1/2".



Replace the "Outer Fabric rectangle" in the Cutting Instructions with the pieced row section. Apply stabilizer after piecing (this helps lock the piecing together). Assemble Pop-Up using FQG122 Stacking Pop-Up pattern. Cut ties and loop from inside fabric.
