

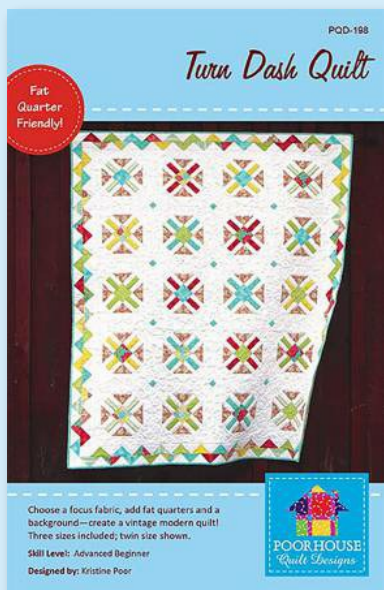
Turn Dash Pop Up

You will need:

- PHD-198 Turn Dash Pattern
- FQG 122 Stacking Pop-Up Pattern
- FQG 123 Medium 8" Spring Refill

Directions:

Make 3 Turn Dash blocks using the PQD-198 Turn Dash pattern, **except: make them at 6½" square**. How? Cut Turn Dash bars at 1¼" wide, Turn Dash HST squares at 3 square, and Turn Dash centers at 2 square.

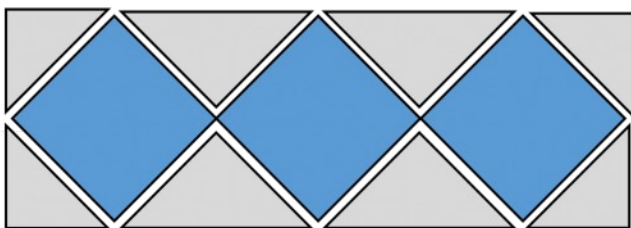
Trim all Turn Dash sections to 2½" square, to make 6½" square blocks.

Cut top and bottom triangles (1) 9¾" – cut in half diagonally twice.

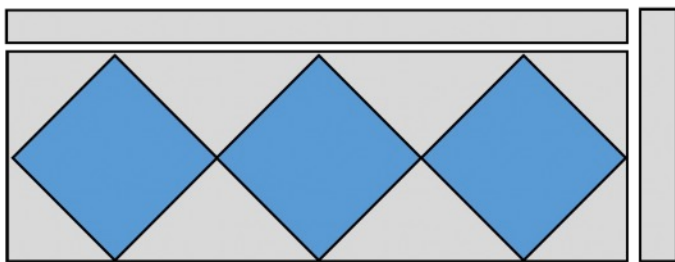
Cut corner triangles (2) 5⅛" – cut in half diagonally.

Cut spacing strips (1) 1¾" x 9½" and (1) 1¾" x 25½".

Assemble blocks and triangle as shown:



Add spacing strips as shown:



Final Size: 9-1/2" x 26-1/2"

To make the pop-up, replace 'Outer Fabric rectangle' in Cutting Instructions with pieced outer fabric section.

Apply Stabilizer after piecing blocks and strips together. Trim to size. Assemble Pop-Up using FQG122 Stacking Pop-Up pattern. Cut Ties/Loops from Inside Fabric.
